There are thousands of significant Black British Icons. To prepare for Black History Week, we want the children to choose one (or more) from the list below. We want them to research the person and produce a poster or booklet about them.

On Friday 20th October, when we share and celebrate what we have learnt they should bring their poster or booklet into school to share with everyone else. This is a homework task and we expect everyone to have a go. Paper is available just ask vour teacher.
