We are delighted to announce that we have signed up to Surfers Against Sewage's - Plastic Free Schools initiative.

12 million tonnes of plastic are pouring into the ocean every year. Plastic has been found in the deepest parts of the ocean, as far away as the Antarctic and across UK beaches. This plastic pollution is choking the ocean. Birds, whales and turtles are killed when they mistake plastics for food or when they get tangled in packaging and ghost fishing gear.

Archbishop Hutton's have signed up to the campaign and will be working to fulfil the campaign's 5 objectives with the aim of eliminating avoidable single-use plastics from our school. The School Council will lead the work, encouraging all of us to get involved and create a positive, lasting environmental change.
