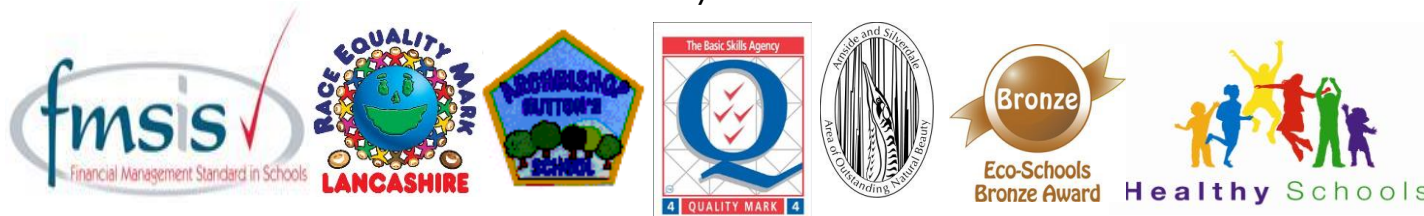

We have reviewed and updated a Long Term Curriculum Plan, parents can view this on the school website CURRICULUM page. This half-term, the whole school are working as History Detectives. Class 1 and Class 2 are learning about **'How My Family Lived'** – Mr. McGurk and Miss.
