Applying for free school meals

Have you recently become eligible for universal credit due to changing employment circumstances?

This may mean that your child/children are also eligible for free school meals.

When you apply for universal credit at www.gov.uk/universal-credit remember to check whether this includes eligibility for free school meals.

If your children are entitled to free school meals, let us know by email or phone. The government have just introduced a system of free school meal vouchers for parents to spend in supermarkets while schools are closed.

As soon as we know your children are eligible, we can organise these vouchers.
